# 2020 Grayslake Arts Festival & Fine Craft Show

## GENERAL INFORMATION

- Entries to the show will be juried by a selection committee.
- All spaces will be assigned by the Arts Festival Committee. We can not guarantee a specific location. Please indicate on your application if you wish to be adjacent to another artist. Corner locations are NOT guaranteed. We will try and honor your request.
- The designed display space is 10' X 10'. If you are exhibiting larger works and require additional space, please indicate this information on your application form. An additional fee of \$50.00 will apply.
- Artists are responsible for providing their own tent, display materials, tables, etc. Spaces will be on Whitney Street, which will be closed to traffic during the festival. Note the LOCATION!
- There will be no commission on sales.
- Due to liability issues, no outside alcohol may be brought to the festival site.
- In order to insure the safety of other artists and festival goers, all motor vehicles must be removed from the street 30 minutes prior to the festival start (9:30 am). Vehicles may be driven onto Whitney Street for takedown, no earlier than 30 minutes after festival end (or 4:30 pm). All vehicles must be off Whitney Street by 6:00 pm.
- Artist vehicles must be parked in the municipal parking lots on Whitney Street or Seymour Avenue during the Festival.

## APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Fees: Please include your application fee, made payable to the Grayslake Chamber of Commerce as follows:

Grayslake Resident: \$75.00

Non-Resident: \$90.00

*2019 Returning Artists—Take \$20 off your application fee if you apply by November 1, 2019*

Fees are refundable only if applicant is not accepted. There will be NO REFUNDS given if the artist cannot participate for any reason. Depositing of your check does not guarantee acceptance in the Grayslake Arts Festival. You will receive a confirmation letter after May 27.

Photos: Attach a minimum of 3 photos of your work along with a self-addresses stamped envelope. Please make sure that your work fits in the self-addressed envelope and proper postage is affixed, otherwise your work will not be returned.
